IROM 300: Palpation Guided International IROM Workshop

IROM 300 is designed to give each physician–learner a direct, high–volume, hands–on treatment experience with live patients, in a controlled and supervised manner.

There are a limited number of physician–learners admitted to IROM 300 such that the maximum student to instructor ratio is 4:1.

The pre–requisites for IROM 300 are:

- i. Be an active member of the AAOM in good standing; AND...
- ii. Have taken Prolotherapy 101; AND
- iii. Have taken AAOM Denver Cadaver Workshop (IROM 200) or prior participation within the last 5 years of any AAOM international workshop.

Curriculum Fulfillment for Specialist in (IROM)

IROM 400: Ultrasound Guided International IROM Workshop

The IROM 400 course is designed for the learner who is interested in increasing the accuracy of their IROM/Prolotherapy injections and/or preparing for more accurate placement of “more advanced” IROM procedures, such as PRP and stem cells.

The physician–learner will be instructed with no more than 4:1 student to instructor ratio.

Will perform US–guided Dextrose–Prolotherapy injections on a minimum of 20 patients, under the supervision of the faculty. Course is limited to 8 physician–learners.

The pre–requisites for IROM 400 are:

- i. Be an active member of the AAOM in good standing; AND...
- ii. Have taken Prolotherapy 101; AND
- iii. Have taken AAOM Denver Cadaver Workshop (IROM 200); AND
- iv. Have taken AAOM Annual Conference or Denver Pre Event Ultrasound Workshop; AND
- v. Received acceptance to IROM 400 by IROM 400 Course Director
